



Percent of Valid Applicants by Primary Subject Area

In 2025, *100&Change* had 666 valid applicants compared to 475 valid applicants in 2021. During the 2025 application cycle, 71 percent of valid applicants worked in the subject areas of health, education, community and economic development, and environment. Below is a comparison of the primary subject areas of the 2025 valid applicant pool compared to the 2021 valid applicant pool:

- Health was identified as the primary subject area for 31 percent of applicants in 2025 and 31 percent of applicants in 2021.
- Education was identified as the primary subject area for 12 percent of applicants in 2025 and 14 percent of applicants in 2021.
- Community and economic development was identified as the primary subject area for 16 percent of applicants in 2025 and 16 percent of applicants in 2021.
- Environment was identified as the primary subject area for 12 percent of applicants in 2025 and 13 percent of applicants in 2021.

The remaining 26 percent of applicants in 2021 and 29 percent in 2025 work in other subject areas including agriculture, fishing, and forestry; arts and culture; information and communications; human rights; human services; public affairs; public safety; philanthropy; and science.
