



Total Applicants Compared to Valid Applicants, Countries with the Highest Density of Applicants by Geographic Region

The *100&Change* applicant pool included 869 total applicants, with 666 valid applicants. Below is a list highlighting the countries within each geographic region with the highest density of applicants. The list is sorted from highest to lowest density of applicants:

- The United States had the highest density of applicants within North America, with 526 total applicants and 426 valid applicants.
- Nigeria had the highest density of applicants within Africa, with 43 total applicants and 27 valid applicants.
- India had the highest density of applicants within Asia, with 39 total applicants and 33 valid applicants.
- The United Kingdom had the highest density of applicants within Europe, with 21 total applicants and 16 valid applicants.
- Brazil had the highest density of applicants within Latin America, with 10 total applicants and 10 valid applicants.
- Australia had the highest density of applicants within Oceania, with 22 total applicants and 19 valid applicants.
